

# Vandalism and its results



At present, bonded windows are the most cost efficient way of vehicle glazing. This initially reduces the purchase price of a vehicle.

## Process-sure bonding requires additional expenses

Further investment such as prolonged idle times for repairs, which are necessary for process-sure bonding, usually are disregarded. Process-sure bonding requires: tempered, dust-free work spaces, sufficient humidity, trained personnel and the storage of glues with limited shelf-life and further resources. These requirements often constitute large inconveniences for many public transportation services.

## Scratched window panes - appealing vehicles?

Ever increasing damages caused by vandalism such as the scratching of window panes mean increasing costs for replacements. For financial reasons, a replacement of the glazing is often waived. The result: the vehicle - a figurehead for the town - is employed with scratched windows over a long period of time.
